

DAY 2 - GLASGOW HISTORY & STIRLING CASTLE

MORNING














DAY 3 - LOCH LOMOND, GLENCOE & LOCH NESS

FULL DAY

DAY 4 - CULLODEN AND EILAN DONAN CASTLE

MORNING

Visit the Culloden Battlefield, where the course of British, European and world history was changed at Culloden on 16 April 1746. A ferocious war had come to Scotland, dividing families and setting clan against clan.

AFTERNOON

Travel Westwards towards the iconic Eilean Donan Castle. Situated on an island at the point where three great sea lochs meet, and surrounded by some majestic scenery, it is little wonder that the castle is now one of the most visited and important attractions in Scotland.

DAY 5 - HIGHLAND COWS AND WHISKY DISTILLERY

FULL DAY

This morning we travel south through the Cairngorm Mountain range and the Perthshire countryside.
